- 3 The purpose of the World Health Organization (WHO) Anatomical Therapeutical Chemical (ATC) classification system is to be used as a tool for drug utilization research in order to improve quality of drug use. Drugs are divided into different groups according to the organ or system on which they act and their chemical, pharmacological and therapeutical properties.
- 4 The AIG number is a 10 digit number that identifies products that have the same active ingredient(s) and ingredient strength(s). The AIG is comprised of three portions:
 - the first portion (2 digits) identifies the number of active ingredients,
 - · the second portion (5 digits) identifies the unique groups of active ingredients(s),
 - the last portion (3 digits) identifies the active ingredient group strength. The strength group has a tolerance of -2% to +10%.
